

Architectural Drafting

Contest Update – March 15, 2021



Preparatory Information

This contest consists of two parts: Hand Drafting and Architectural Drafting (1 ½ hours), and Computer-Aided Drafting (4 hours). It is not necessary to use the entire time allotted. Both tasks must be completed in the same day. Competitors may take break in between the two parts for no more than 10 minutes.

Students will open the envelope for each portion of the competition on camera. Time will begin when the envelope is opened. After the first task is completed and the student is ready to proceed to part 2, they will open the second envelope on camera. Time will begin when the envelope is opened. Don't forget to record the opening of the envelopes.

Contest materials must remain sealed until the competition. Failure to comply will result in penalties or disqualification.

If a student needs a restroom break during the competition, they may take a break, but the camera should continue to record their workstation in their absence. No additional time is provided and time may not be made up if a student must take a break.

Vellum paper is provided for each contestant in the Contest Prep Box. Each competitor has three (3) sheets of 11" x 17" paper for use during Part 1. Final submissions must be completed on the paper provided. Any other unused paper (graph or plain) may be used for sketching, notes and preparation.

Submitted files must be in the designated format and named according to the [Virtual General Regulations](#).
