

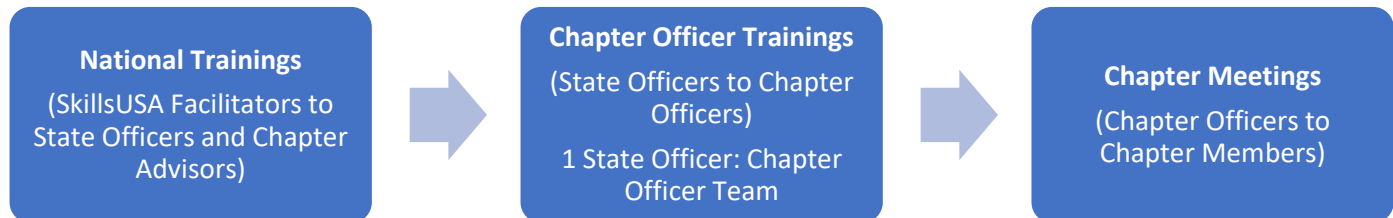

Overview

As part of 2021-22 national programming for local chapters, IMPACT will be offered as a virtual experience for state officer teams to engage local chapter officer teams. The program begins with live virtual training for state officers to help them be prepared to facilitate virtual local chapter officer trainings. Local chapter officer trainings are offered in a series of five training topics, and local advisors can also attend a separate national training to learn how to support their chapter around each topic. Following the national training with state officers, they will facilitate a local chapter officer team training. From there, chapter officers will be able to lead a lesson plan on the same topic for your whole chapter. Be sure to connect with your state director to determine when your state is offering the trainings for chapter officers.



Local Chapter Roles and Responsibilities

Chapter Officers

Following each training with the state officer, chapter officers will receive a lesson plan to implement during a chapter meeting with their members to continue the IMPACT. The easy-to-follow lesson plans outline both in-person and virtual delivery options.

- Engage in state officer-led chapter officer trainings.
- Schedule meetings for chapter members.
- Prepare to facilitate chapter meetings by reviewing the provided lesson plan for in-person or virtual delivery.
- Practice facilitating each lesson before the live chapter meeting.

Advisors

The advisor's role is to provide support as needed to the state officer and chapter officers during their trainings.

- Schedule and share a video conference platform invitation (Zoom, Google Meet, Adobe Connect, Microsoft Teams, etc.).
- Assist state officer during chapter officer trainings.
- Check in with chapter officers following their training to ensure they have properly prepared for their lesson with chapter members.
- Encourage chapter officers to schedule chapter meetings with members.
- Assist chapter officers when facilitating the lessons during meetings.
- Facilitate reflection conversation with chapter officers to discuss what went well and what could be improved for the next chapter meeting.
