
The SkillsUSA Framework is the foundation of all our programs. It's made up of three components: Personal, Workplace and Technical Skills grounded in academics.

SLSC 2024 BY THE NUMBERS

Total attendance of **2,416** includes:

269 educators representing 71 CTE program areas

1,319 student competitors in 103 hands-on technical or leadership contests Over **100 students** served as voting delegates, volunteers or observers

Attendees were **55% male**

40% female (of those reporting)

Of those students attending, 66% are high school, 33% college/postsecondary and 1% are middle school




