All purchases are final, and no refunds will be issued. Children under age 12 are admitted at no cost, and must attend with and be supervised by an adult (age 21+). By purchasing admission, individuals agree to abide by all posted rules and regulations, including but not limited to the <u>Inclusivity Statement and Expectations</u>. Entry to events is permitted only with proper credentials. Some competitions may not be accessible, and purchasing admission does not guarantee that any specific event may be viewed.

CONFERENCE BADGE

The Conference Badge includes all conference activities, including Opening Ceremony, competitions, Champions' Festival (including dinner), Closing Ceremony, and more! The full conference registration fee is \$150 per person ages 12 and older. Conference badges are available for prepurchase online or can be purchased onsite with cash or credit card.

COMPETITION DAY PASS

To access competitions, purchase a Competition Day Pass for each attendee age 12 and older. The pass provides access to the Hyatt and Prime Osborn Convention Center from 8 AM to 4 PM at on Tuesday, April 29 and Wednesday, April 30 for \$35. Each pass is valid for both days of competition. Purchase passes online in advance, or onsite with cash or credit card. Day passes do not provide admission to the Opening or Closing sessions, conference transportation, Champions' Festival, or other conference activities. To take advantage of the full conference experience, purchase a Conference Badge; to access the Closing Ceremony and competitions only, purchase a Day Pass and a Ticket (below).

CLOSING CEREMONY TICKETS

During the Closing Ceremony on May 1, 2025, we recognize our medalists in each competition and division, install our new State Officer team, and announce the National Courtesy Corps delegation. Attending the Closing Ceremony requires a conference name badge or purchased ticket for entry. Tickets are \$25 per person and are available for advance purchase and onsite. Online ticket purchases are strongly encouraged; limited onsite sales are available and may delay entry into the event. Ticket holders will enter the ceremony through a designated entrance and proceed to the designated seating area. Five minutes prior to the ceremony, ticket holders may relocate to any open seats, allowing us to ensure that students and teachers have closest and preferential access to the stage. Doors open at 7:30 AM, and the ceremony begins at 8:30 AM; Hyatt Regency Jacksonville Riverfront Grand Ballroom.
